



### Application Fee Waiver

Each applicant of Indigenous ancestry can use **two free** admissions applications per academic year:

- One application to a college certificate or diploma program
- One application to a high school upgrading program

## English Language Learning for Immigrant Youth

## Bridge Program (ELL)

 For students who completed grade 9 or less in their home countries and have credit in LEAD, ELL, -3 or -4 courses, or 14 and 24 courses

### Youth in Transition (LINC)

 For students who completed grade 10 or higher before Canada and have credit in English Language Arts -1 or -2 course plus credit in Math 10C

We're working with C-LARC to create a streamlined process to transition ESL high school students into these programs
