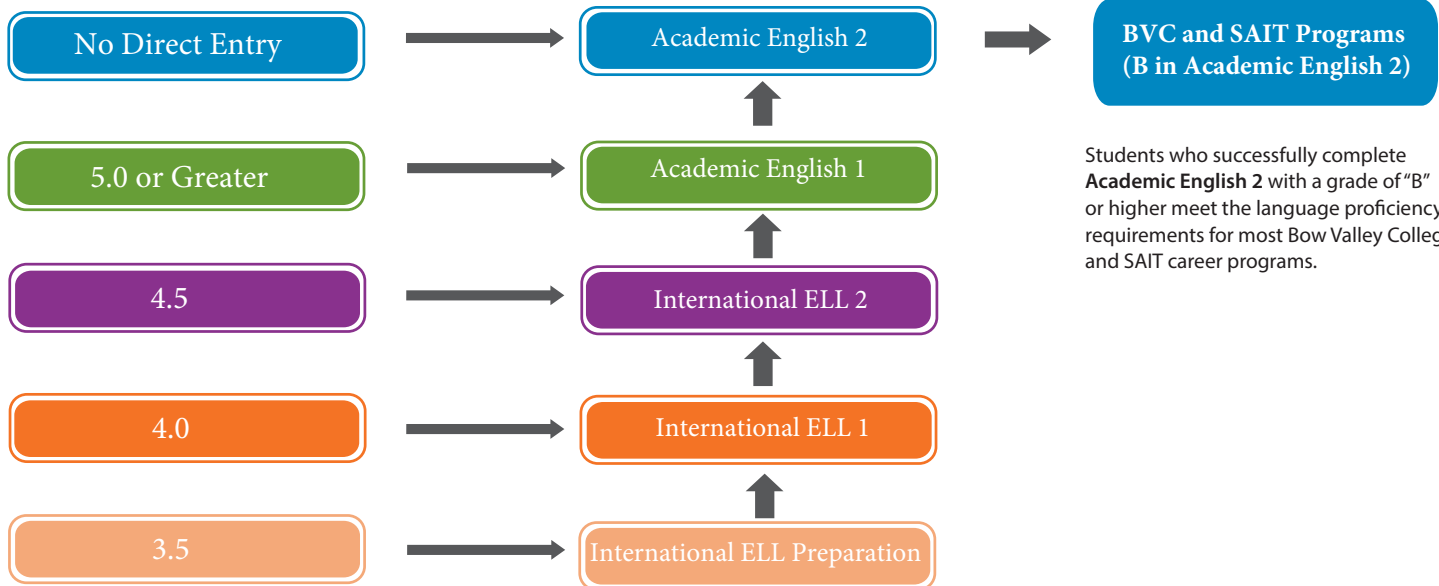
Program Structure and Learner Progression

Applicants need to submit **IELTS Academic** or **Equivalent test results** for admission and level placement. The lowest bandscore level of the IELTS Academic test results will determine the corresponding International English Language Learning program level.
