

University Transfer students can choose from a variety of courses to create a path towards a future degree at a post-secondary institution of their choice*. You can complete up to two years towards a Bachelor of Arts degree here at Bow Valley College, or one year towards a Bachelor of Science. You can also complete courses towards a Business Administration degree and more, depending on program requirements and transfer credit guidelines.

Below are **example pathways**** for Bachelor of Science degrees at Mount Royal University or the University of Calgary, as well as the Bachelor of Kinesiology degree at the University of Calgary. Please note that all transfer students must meet the admission requirements of the university to which they are applying.

^{*}Each post-secondary institution and program will have its own entry requirements. Completing courses at Bow Valley College through University Transfer will not guarantee admission to these programs. Students will still need to apply to the university of their choice.

^{**}Courses need not be taken in this sequence and some courses may be swapped out for different options. For MRU, see the breakdown of GNED courses on the next page for an idea of which courses can be replaced to still meet GNED requirements.



Most degrees at Mount Royal University require ten courses in General Education (GNED). GNED courses consist of four clusters:

- 1 Numeracy and Scientific Literacy
- 2. Values, Beliefs, and Identity
- 3. Community and Society
- 4. Communication

with three tiers (Foundation, Intermediate, Advanced).

Students must take one tier 1 course from all four clusters. In Arts and Business Administration degrees students must take one tier 2 course from cluster 1 and may take two tier 2 courses from two of clusters 2-4. They then can take either three tier 3 courses from three different clusters, or two from one cluster and one from a different cluster. For Science degrees, the only difference is that the tier 2 options must be one from each of clusters 2-4.
