Provide Supporting Documents

To decrease processing times, we request all supporting documents for a complete application package be submitted as email attachments. Documents from each category below should be attached to your email <u>as a separate file</u>.

- - High School Transcripts and Diploma (required)
 - Post-Secondary/University Transcripts and Diploma (if applicable)
 - *Academic requirements are not required for English Language Learning program applications.
- ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS
 - Proof of English language proficiency is required for all career program applicants and for English language learners applying to intakes <u>starting in 2018</u>.

 - * Please Note: If your test was in Canada, you must submit the original results (not a copy).
- OPY of VALID STUDY PERMIT or STUDENT VISA (if available)
- CONSENT to RELEASE INFORMATION (CRI) FORM (if applicable)
 - This form authorizes Bow Valley College to release information regarding your student record to a specified individual, including an agent, relative, friend, or other person acting on your behalf.
 - Download the CRI form at international.bowvalleycollege.ca/apply under Steps to Apply #4.

English Language Learning Program

Certificate and Diploma Programs

 Average application processing is 3-4 weeks, <u>after a complete application package is received</u>. If you have not heard from us within four weeks of submitting your complete application package please contact the International Education department.

IF YOU ARE ACCEPTED TO A PROGRAM:

MyBVC Account Login And Information

- You will receive an e-mail from <u>accountManager@bowvalleycollege.ca</u> with your online account information. The subject line will read: Bow Valley College Student ID#### New MyBVC User Account.
- Please login right away as the temporary password is only valid for a short time and the MyBVC email will be the primary form of communication with Bow Valley College.

Offer Of Admission

- After your myBVC login information, you will be emailed an Offer of Admission. **Unless you are accepted from a waitlist**, your offer will be valid for 2 weeks.
- To reserve your seat in the program, you must pay the **non-refundable and non-transferable** \$1500 confirmation fee by the Offer of Admission due date.
- **Before paying the non-refundable, non-transferable Confirmation Fee**, students are urged to ensure the program start date is feasible according to the study permit processing time estimates through the Citizenship and Immigration Canada's website at www.cic.gc.ca/english/information/times/index.asp.

GETTING READY TO START:

Apply For Your Study Permit

- It is important to apply for a Study Permit <u>as soon as possible</u> and within the posted processing times. As soon as you receive your study permit or Study Permit Approval letter, email a copy to <u>issc@bowvalleycollege.ca</u>.
- Students who do not submit proof of a valid study permit or approval letter at least 2 weeks prior to the International Learner Preparation Day (ILPD) risk losing the \$1500 Confirmation Fee.
