

# **Return to Campus Update/WINTER 2022**

In follow up to Bow Valley College's December 21<sup>st</sup> decision to **start the new term with a temporary switch to online learning until at least January 21, 2022,** please find additional information for international students.

## How this impacts students inside of Canada

- Please note, that as this is a temporary measure, international students should be prepared to come to campus as soon as in-person classes resume
- As all course types will be shifted to online delivery, therefore there will not be any impact to your study permit or post-graduation work permit, per IRCC guidelines on Post-Graduation Work Permit (PGWP) eligibility: <u>Coronavirus disease (COVID-19)</u>: <u>International students - Canada.ca</u>

## How this impacts students outside of Canada

- You will continue with your classes as usual, as courses originally delivered online, will resume as usual for the remainder of the term
