I was named in a Code of Conduct Report, what happens next?

You will receive a request from the Learner Conduct Officer to discuss the concerns reported.

The information reported will be presented to you.

The Learner Conduct Officer reviews all the information presented and makes a recommendation to the decision maker. You will have an opportunity to respond to the information and provide any witnesses or evidence to support your statement.

The outcome of the investigation will be communicated to you. This means you will be told if you were found in violation of the Policy or not, based on a balance of probabilities.

If you are not found in violation, the investigation is complete.

If you do not agree with the decision, you may be eligible to appeal through the Learner Appeals Policy. If you are found in violation of the Policy, sanctions may be issued and communicated.
