## **Guiding Principles for Academic Scenarios**

- 1. The health and wellbeing of students, staff, and faculty are priority when making decisions about academic continuity and program delivery methods.
- 2. Where possible, maintaining the academic success of students by meeting graduation, course progression, accreditation requirements, and contract funding criteria will be priority to not delay student completion or impact grants and financial aid.
- 3. Decisions made on delivery mode will ensure that students from various backgrounds and programs with unique needs will be considered and accommodated to the best of our abilities.
- 4. We will provide as much certainty to students, faculty, and staff by making and communicating decisions as soon as possible.
- 5. We will leverage the infrastructure created to support remote work and learning while capitalizing on lessons learned to enhance operations, sustainability and service delivery.
